ICBC BAPTISM POLICY

Date approved: 19.2.20

Review date: 2023

RATIONALE:

Baptism is an important part of a person's spiritual journey. It is a public affirmation of a personal commitment to Christ and a recognition of a person belonging to the family of God.

POLICY

- Baptisms should not take place until an appropriate Ministry Leader has met with the person and
 affirmed their suitability. This should happen early in the process, before dates and planning for the
 event have occurred.
- Baptisms are to take place publicly. If they do not take place in a Sunday service, they are to be publicly announced the week before so that anyone can attend if they so wish.
