ICBC OVERSEAS MISSION POLICY

Date ratified: 18 July 2022

Review date: 2025

Overseas Mission is an important part of the life of the church. It comes under the Reach Ministry, and is to be overseen by a team (Global Action Team, or GAT).

- 1. The GAT team will have 7 key functions:
 - 1. Promotion of mission/keeping mission in the forefront of our minds
 - 2. Promotion of prayerful support
 - 3. Encouraging giving for mission
 - 4. Encouraging people into mission
 - 5. Supporting people in mission
 - 6. Supporting returned mission partners
 - 7. Preparing a budget for the distribution of mission giving, having established pre determined guidelines, that are approved by the Reach Ministry Leader and the Lead Pastor.
- 2. The GAT team leader will be appointed by the Reach Ministry Leader and Lead Pastor.
- 3. The GAT team will have a minimum of 4 members, with the Reach Ministry Leader and Lead Pastor being ex officio members. GAT team members will be appointed by the GAT team leader, or Reach Ministry Leader.
- 4. If the GAT team is unable to perform its functions, these will be fulfilled where possible by the Reach Ministry Leader.
- 5. A minimum of 2% of general giving will be given to overseas mission.
- 6. The budget for the distribution of mission giving will be approved at the AGM, and any changes through the year must be approved by the Ministry Leadership Team.
- 7. Priority for the distribution of funds will be given to those who are partners of ICBC, and then those who have a relationship with ICBC.
